Is faoi gach Bord Bainistíochta na treoirlínte maidir le héide scoile a leagan amach. (*Preis ráiteas an Aire Oideachais agus Eolaíochta agus an Aire Leanaí Meán Fómhair 23 2008*) Cuireadh tús leis an bpolasaí seo a chur le chéile i bhFeabhra 2009 tar éis d'fhoireann na scoile an t-ábhar a phlé ar an 16ú Eanáir 2009. Ghlac Ríona de Liostúin freaghracht uirthi féin an polasaí a dhréachtú. Bhí comhpháirtíocht ann idir dhaltaí, tuismitheoirí, múinteoirí agus an Bord Bainistíochta.

Sa bhliain 2022 bhí sé beartaithe ag foireann na scoile go mbeadh uasdátú ag teastál ón bpolasaí. An réasúnaíocht a bhí ann nánchun deimhin a dhéanamh go raibh na rannpháirtithe ar fad sásta agus chun uasdátú a dhéanamh air toisc athrú meoin, gánna agus fócas níos mó ar an bhfoghlaim lasmuigh de bharr an paindéim Covid-19

Bhí an polasaí athphléite le foireann na scoile (19 Deireadh Fómhair 22), leis an mBord Bainistíochta (Deireadh Fómhair 22) agus leis na tuismitheoirí / caomhnóirí (18 Deireadh Fómhair 22). Réasúnaíocht

Caitheann gach páiste i nGaelscoil Sáirséal éide scoile. Tá éide spóirt ann do na laethanta a bhíonn rang Corp Oideachais (CO) ar siúl. Bíonn solúbhthacht ann do foirne spóirt ar laethanta ina mbíonn cluichí peile nó eachtraí luthchleasaíochta mar shampla.

Spreagtar daltaí na Gaelscoile chun bheith bródúil as cuma néata a bheith orthu i gcónai. Is ambasadóirí na scoile iad nuair atá an éide scoile orthu.

An Éide Scoile

Tá éide scoile ann do gach pháiste agus tá roghanna difriúla ann ag braith ar rogha an pháiste. Tá an éide spóirt chéanna ag gach duine.

Background

It is the responsibility of the Board of Management to create a set of guidelines for the school uniform (Press Statement from Department of Education and Science and the Minister for Children and Youth Affairs, 23rd September 2008). This policy was created in February 2009, after being discussed with school staff on the 16th January 2009. Ríona de Liostúin was responsible for drafting the policy following on from cooperation and collaboration between Board of Management, staff, parents and pupils.

In 2022 it was agreed by school staff that the policy needed to be updated again. The rationale behind this was to ensure all stakeholders were satisfied and to update due to changing perspectives, needs and increased focus on outdoor learning, brought about by the Covid-19 pandemic

The policy was re-discussed by school staff (19 October 2022), with the Board of Management (June 2023) and with the Parents' Association (18 October 2022). The Principal, Ian Ó Madagáin and Deputy Principal, Ríona Uí Cheallaigh, accepted responsibility for updating the policy. This policy was ratified by the Board of Management on the ****

Rationale

Every child in Gaelscoil Sáirséal wears a uniform. There is a school tracksuit for days in which there is Physical Education (PE). Flexibility may be exercised on match days for sports teams, for example on days when there is a football match or an athletics event.

Pupils of Gaelscoil Sáirséal are always encouraged to be proud of presenting themselves neatly. They are school ambassadors whenever they are wearing their school uniform.

The School Uniform

The school uniform is for all children and has an element of choice, depending on the child's preference. The tracksuit is the same for all children.
